“Doc-a-Day” Haiti Medical Effort

St. Monica’s **Haiti Medical Effort** has an opportunity to hire a physician to provide continuous medical care for the patients of the Whitney Clinic in Haiti for five days a week all year round. This will be the first time that medical care will be available on a daily basis for our brothers and sisters at Parish Sacre Couer in Hinche. But the Medical Mission Team is desperately asking for your help to raise the funds necessary to pay this physician’s salary, which amounts to nearly \$15,000 per year. *For a donation of only \$60 you can purchase the presence of a physician in the Whitney clinic for one full day.* Prior to the opening of clinic on that day, a prayer will be said by Father Jean Navarre Bourdeau, pastor of Parish Sacre Couer, for the person/family/special intention of your choice. If you’ve wanted to be involved in the medical mission effort in the past but weren’t sure how...this is your chance! Please be generous in your support of this worthwhile effort. Get your family, place of business, classroom involved! A notification card will be sent upon receipt of your donation. Your continued support of the Haiti Medical Effort is greatly appreciated.

Doc-a-Day Fundraiser Instruction Sheet

For each intention received, a prayer will be said at the beginning of the Whitney Clinic opening each day by Father Bourdeau in Haiti for the person or occasion being honored.

1. Complete a separate form for **each intention**/donation.
2. Write the check to Catholic Church of Saint Monica. You may write **one check** for multiple donations (\$60/day requested).
3. Write "Doc-a-Day" on the check in the memo section to ensure the donation gets put in the proper account.
4. Enclose the check and the form(s) into an envelope and mark the envelope "Doc-a-Day".
5. Turn in envelope to the office, leave in the offertory basket on Sunday, or leave in the mailbox outside the RE building.
6. Please do not fill out the calendar yourself. We have volunteers that complete the calendar and fill out the intention cards as the forms are received. If you are concerned about when your request will get written on the calendar or if you need an intention card sent sooner, contact one of the volunteer below.

Write the actual date requested on your form. Even if the day you want is already taken, we will be sure that the notification card reflects the actual day even if we have to substitute a day on the calendar. The intention will be written on the display calendar on the day **closest** to the requested day. This will also be true for weekend days since the clinic is only opened Monday through Friday.

Intention cards will be mailed to recipients shortly before the day you requested to make the receipt of the card more meaningful. Example: If you turn in a form in February requesting June 15th as your special intention day, the recipient will be mailed the intention card during June, and not in February. If you have any special request for mailings, just let us know.
