Suggestions of what you may need to bring – Be sure your name is on EVERYTHING!

- Sewing supplies needed for your class. (Check your supply list.)
- All the parts to your machine (foot control, cord, assorted feet and attachments, instruction book, extra needles, bobbins, extra light bulb)
- Rotary mat, rulers and cutter with an extra blade (check your class supply list)
- Basic sewing supplies such as scissors (fabric and paper), threads, needles, seam ripper and other basic supplies (check your class supply list for specific needs)
- Marking tools and pencil sharpener
- Small iron and mat, if convenient, we can share (We are limited to the number of irons that can be used at one time!)
- Pen or pencil and notebook
- Pillow to sit on while sewing
- Extra extension cord or power strip
- Small sewing light
- An extra project to work on when not busy in class
- Comfortable clothing (this is not a fancy retreat)
- Toiletries
- Sweater or jacket (in case the room is cool)
- Umbrella (in case it is raining at mealtime)
- Extra towels (The conference center provides one set of *white* towels and sheets per person. We will not have maid service during our stay. You may want to bring an additional set of non-white towels.)
- Insulated mug with a tight lid
- Favorite pillow and quilt for cuddling
- Camera and film
- *Quilt and Tell* item
- Change for the vending machine
- Calling card (prepaid) for pay phone
- Whatever you forgot last year
