This book is a continuation of Dr. Nolan's two previous volumes and will trace the last 25 years of history. It celebrates the 175th anniversary of the arrival of Mother Thérèse Chevrel and Sister Augustin Clerc in Louisiana in 1833. The volumes examine the community's changing role in church and society in the United States and the Philippines and its expanding role in the global church. Dr. Nolan weaves together general events and trends with numerous accounts of and reflections by individual sisters to examine administration, personnel, education, health care, new ministries, a growing social outreach, Carmelite Spirituality, Lay Carmelites, and the impact of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita.

Water is a basic Christian symbol. It has taken on a special significance for the Sisters of Mount Carmel from the 1833 crossing of the Atlantic by Mother Thérèse Chevrel and Sister Augustine Clerc to the 2005 devastation and uprooting of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita. Water is a apt expression of the many changes, the many transitions, the community has experienced.
